MESSAGE FROM OUR MINISTER

What has to take place for me to become loving toward myself? One does not learn to love himself or herself in isolation. We learn to love ourselves as we enter into personal relationship with both God and man, and the relationship we have with God is very closely tied to the one we have with man or woman. When we receive love from God we open up a line to receive from our brother or sister, and when we receive love from our brother or sister we also receive it from God. 1 John 4:20 "If someone says he loves God but hates his brother, he is a liar. For he cannot love God whom he has not seen, if he does not love his brother whom he has seen."

In order to love myself I must encounter self-awareness. I must know what I am and am not. I must look critically at myself and be aware of both my weaknesses and strength. To let defences down and admit a weakness can be a fearful and confusing experience. If God already knows me as I am, it is ridiculous for me to put on a mask before him.

Self-acceptance is another encounter. Here I gain the freedom to be what I am. I can say, "This is me – this is where I stand right now. I am able to accept myself because God in Christ has accepted me as I am." He did not say, "I will only accept you if" but "I will accept you in spite of your shortcomings and failures." In self-giving you are to love yourself in order to give love to others. Loving self and neighbour is never easy or complete, but it is the starting point for authentic journeys to life's goals.

The world will become a better place if we are able to love ourselves and then love our neighbours.
