MESSAGE FROM THE MINISTER

Dear Friends,

As I write this, it's the Sunday just before Lent, when we remember Jesus' Transfiguration. It's a "high" point, when Jesus is revealed as He really is. But I've often wondered: why do we remember this now, just before Lent, a "low" point as we remember Jesus' temptations, the loneliness of the wilderness, and perhaps confront our own demons? We may one day feel really close to God, then the next day life seems to hit back at us. As I was in the middle of writing this, I had a phone call, telling me of the death of a dearly loved member of our church family. A dear friend whom we shall deeply miss- and so soon after another sad loss. We may look at the high points, and the rubbish that everyday life throws at us, and wonder, "Which is reality?"

I wonder whether remembering Transfiguration, and Lent, so close together, actually reminds us that *both* are reality. Straight after the Transfiguration, Jesus and His friends come down off the mountain, into dealing with all sorts. Life is sometimes amazing, and sometimes it's rubbish. We know that one day all things will be made new in Christ but it hasn't happened yet. God's love has touched our lives, and yet it doesn't always feel like it. And yet, the transfigured Christ is also Lord of our wilderness, who leads us through. Sometimes His light is more like sunrise on a winter morning, or winter sunlight through bare trees, than a dazzling glow. I pray that in our dark times, we may know the Lord of the wilderness, the crucified Christ, who is also the transfigured, risen and ascended Christ, close to us, bringing light in our darkness.
